DOH-Miami-Dade WIC Program: Carla Sabugo shared an update on the 11th Annual Homestead/Florida City Holiday Health & Resource Fair that was hosted on Saturday, December 7th, 2024. During this event, they hosted a toy drive during the holiday season and was able to give out 1,600 toys. On April 30th, 2025, there will be a similar community resource fair but, on a smaller scale for WIC staff members to learn about the community partners and resources available they can take back to the clients they serve and connect them to services.
